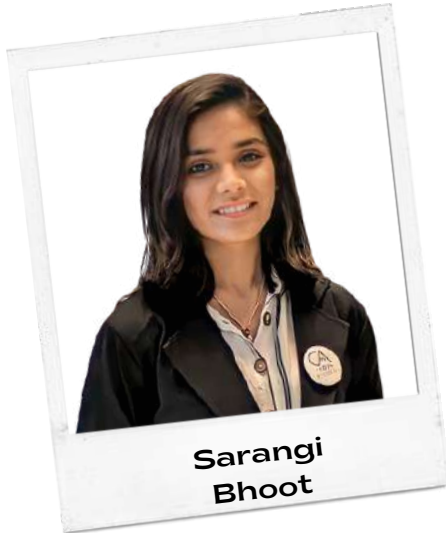

A TIP THAT CAN BLOW YOUR CAPITAL OR EXPLODE IT!!!

Trying stock tips given by various sources on different platforms is not always a good choice to earn a good profit on your investments, but there is no harm in doing a paper trade of the whole tip and know the outcome.

So, one day while observing various telegram channels and searching for opportunities to get a good trade led us to a tip about a stock, and we got what we were looking for.

Day 1: We got a tip through the telegram channels (2 of them) which suggested to buy a stock of a company (which was a penny stock) which was trading at a price of around 10 per stock. We thought that this can be an opportunity to explode our capital but due to our professional scepticism we thought to check the accuracy of these channels by watching their previously given tips and when we did that there were near to no good signs that displayed the trustworthiness of these channels.



But when we dig further into that stock, we came to know a fact that the stock price was already on upper circuit(An upper circuit is a situation when the stock hits the maximum price on which it trades for a particular day and when a stock hits upper circuit there are no sellers for the same) and it was the straight 3rd day the stock got upper circuit, going further into that stock, the price was around RS. 8 before the tip started to circulate in the social media via all these telegram channels.

So, we assumed that it can be either these tippers or the company itself who spread the news to possibly manipulate the price of the stock.

If it was done by the tippers, then they must have bought the stock at RS. 8 or lower and then might have started to circulate the tips and then because of excessive and mass buying, the price of stock may have rose which equals to a profit of Rs. 2 per stock or more which might look small but is a profit of 25%. Now just imagine having bought 1,00,000 quantity which is equal to a profit of RS. 2,00,000 or more.

Day 2: The price has increased again by 1 RS tip seems to work well, though we didn't invest in it but we had started to develop a feeling of an opportunity cost been bared. As the target given by the tippers was of about 15/20/25.



Day 3: No significant fluctuation in the prices.

Day 4: The price rose to 12 per stock, roughly 1Rs increased in the price, now the target of 15/20/25 looks achievable.

Day 5: There was a slight drop in the price of the stock by 0.5 Rs but still market seems bullish.

Day 6: The stock showed some warmth towards the bear side of the market and fell by 1 Rs

Day 7: The stock got lower circuit (A lower circuit is a situation when the stock hits the lowest price on which it trades for a particular day and when a stock hits lower circuit there are no buyers for the same)

Day 8: The stock still bleeds and falls more by 1Rs and the opportunity loss which we had from Day 2 now seems to be a good self-control towards greed.



Day 9: There hardly seems any sign of the stock going in a good position and stays at the same price. At the end what we thought was that it can be possible that the stock prices might have been inflated by these anonymous tippers. And they would have taken advantage of these market momentum created because of their followers.

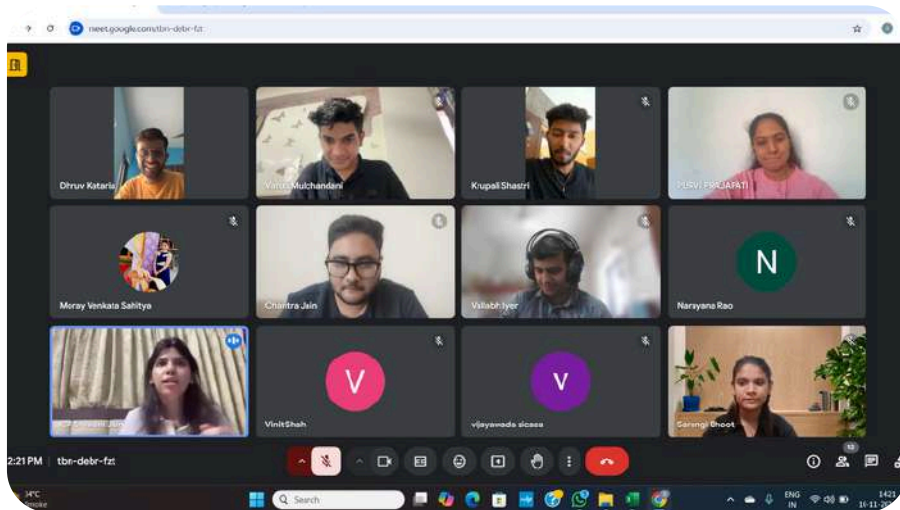
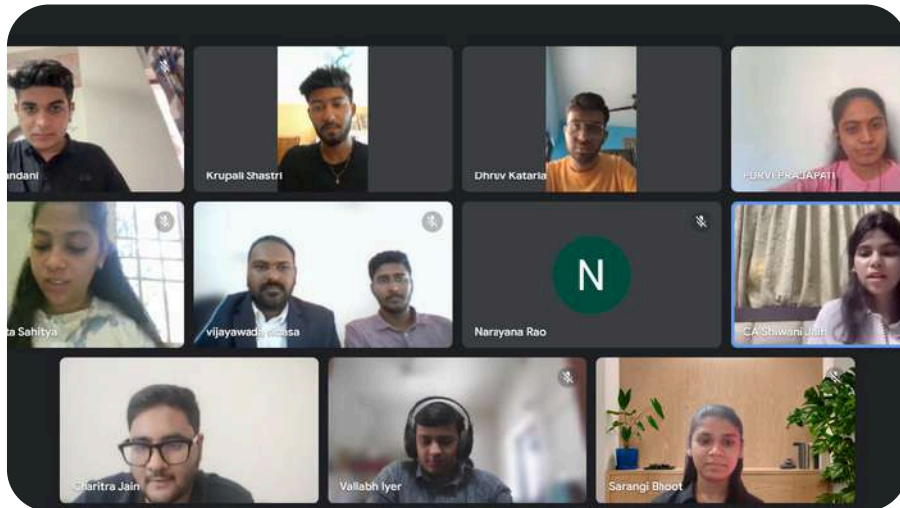
One could have earned a profit not as the target given but to some what extent. The tippers used their followings to inflate the stock price. We, being the followers, can use the momentum gained by the market and have a quick entry and exit trade in addition to a good profit as well.

The only question you should be aware about is YOUR ENTRY AND EXIT strategy.

And the end all one should keep in mind that the person who circulates the tip are humans too at the end of the day, so there can always be a possibility of error in any circulations or estimates. And if you believe them and their tips to be true then you cannot blame them for your losses. As someone has said, "No one can manipulate you, unless you want them to."
